Purpose

Columns with “_duration’ provide the duration of the assignment. Columns with “Actual_Days” represent the total number of instructional days the duration of the assignment occurred. Example: the student was assigned a partial day ISS that was .2 of the day, another partial day ISS of .3 of the day and then a full day ISS for 3 days, the duration columns would sum the total duration to 3.5 days. The “Actual_Days” column would total to 5 to indicate that the student received either a full day or partial day ISS over 5 instructional days.

What to Review

Review the incident, participant, behavior, action, victim, weapon, duration, and school information needed to understand the reported result.

DISC_Removal_Duration	Displays the reported duration of a qualifying disciplinary removal action.
ISS_Actual_Days	Displays the calculated In School Suspension (ISS) days used for reporting.
OSS_Actual_Days	Displays the calculated Out of School Suspension (OSS) days used for reporting.
ENALP_Actual_Days	Displays the calculated Alternative Learning Program (ALP) placement days used for reporting.
Removal_Actual_Days	Displays the calculated disciplinary removal days used for reporting.
Data_As_of_DateTime	Timestamp of duration information.
